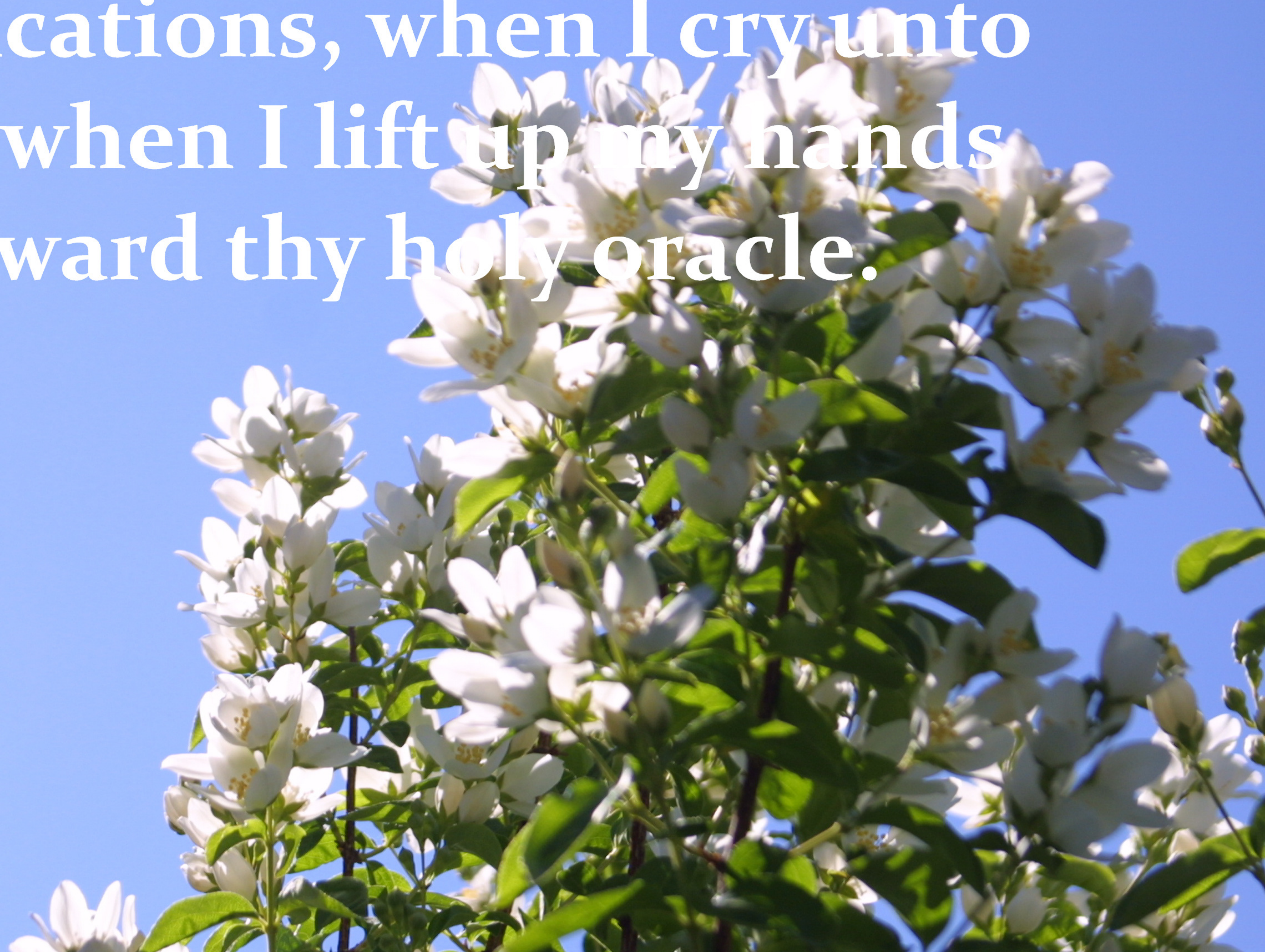


**Psalm 28:01 A Psalm of David.

toward thy holy oracle.




**Psalm 28:03 Draw me not away
