



Psalms 141:01 A Psalm of David.

my lips.




Psalms 141:04 Incline not my heart

are sweet.




Psalms 141:07 Our bones are

wood upon the earth.




Psalms 141:08 But mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
