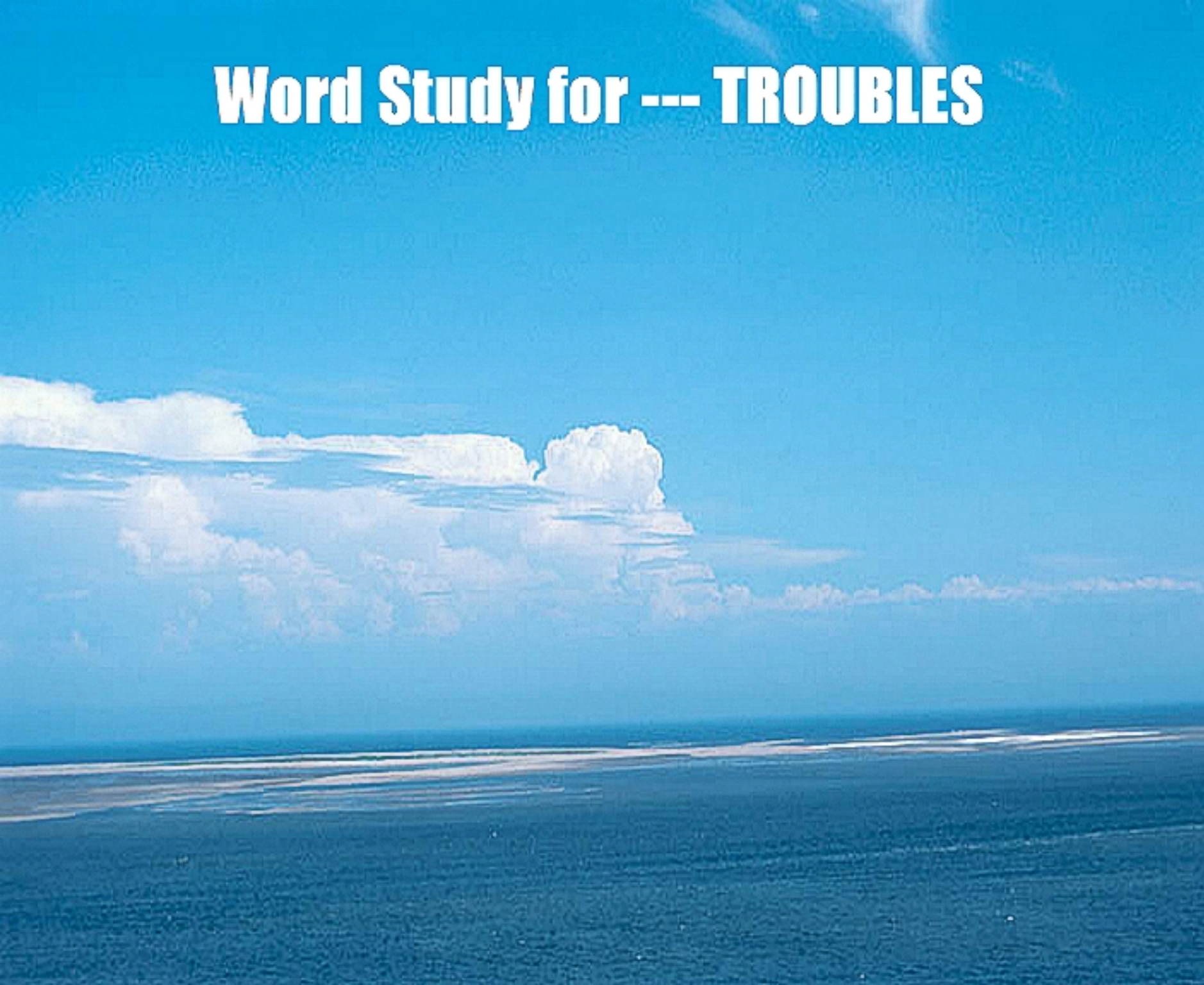

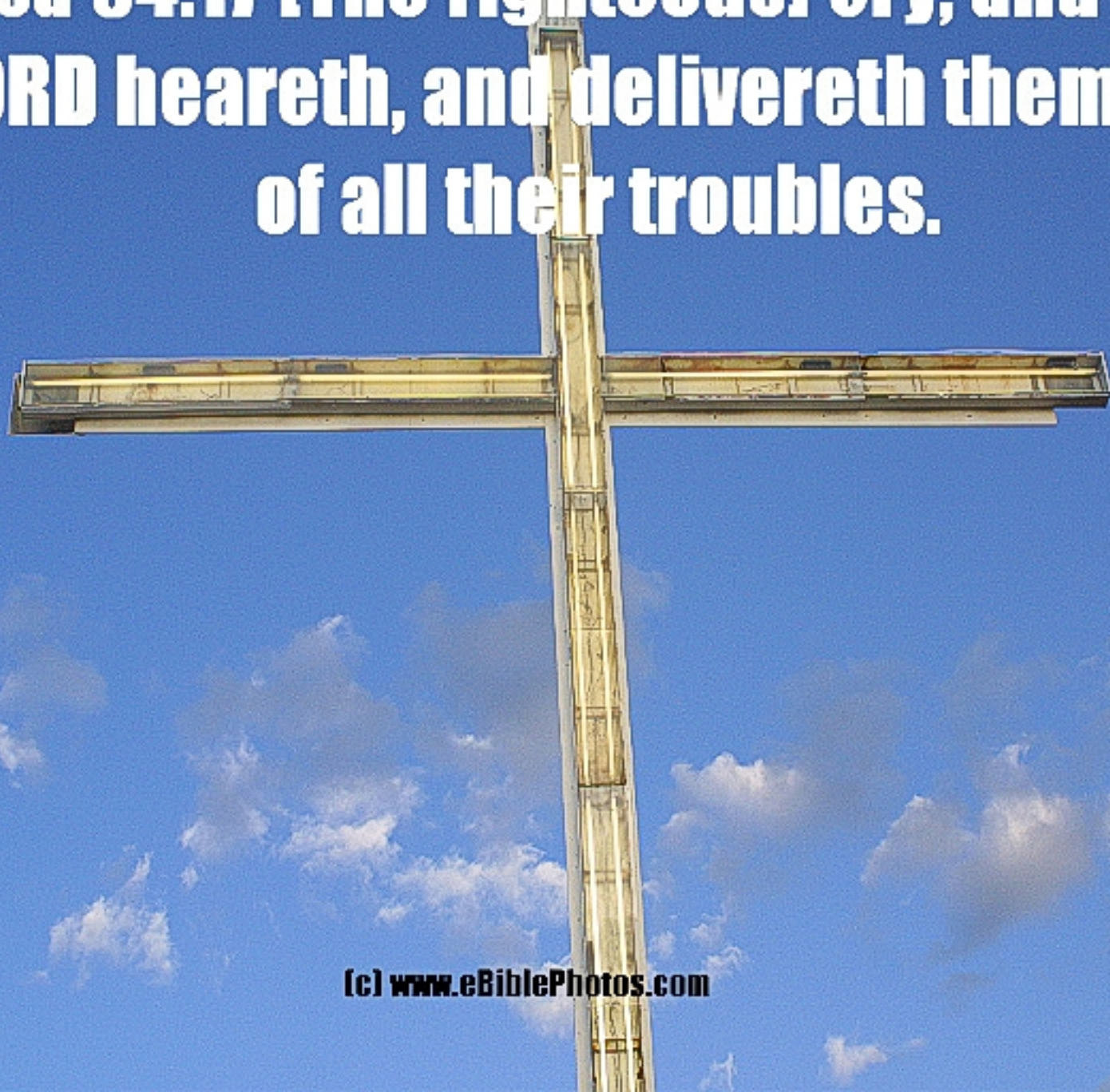


**Psa 25:17 The troubles of my heart are

of all their troubles.**




